

General Information:

A Counselor in Training (CIT) is a young person who desires to learn the leadership skills of a camp counselor. The program will provide CIT's with hands on experience working with young campers and teach them valuable leadership and life skills that will help develop the person and will help youth to realize their full potential. The CIT works together with other CIT's, camp counselors, and the camp director.

Program Description:

The Counselor in Training program is a special opportunity for 13-15 year old to learn the skills needed to work with children in a camp setting. All participants are mentored by camp counselors and are supervised while working with campers. CIT's will assist in providing activities to campers in a safe and supervised environment. Participants must be available to attend all trainings and be available to volunteer for a minimum of 2 weeks. Training covers issues and concerns that the CIT would encounter in camp life, including discipline, safety and awareness, being a role model, and creative planning.

The application packet must be filled out completely and returned to United Sports by April 1, 2016. Once the packet is received, interviews will be scheduled. Only those who complete the package will be considered. Not all applicants are accepted.
